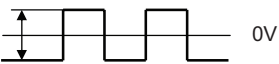

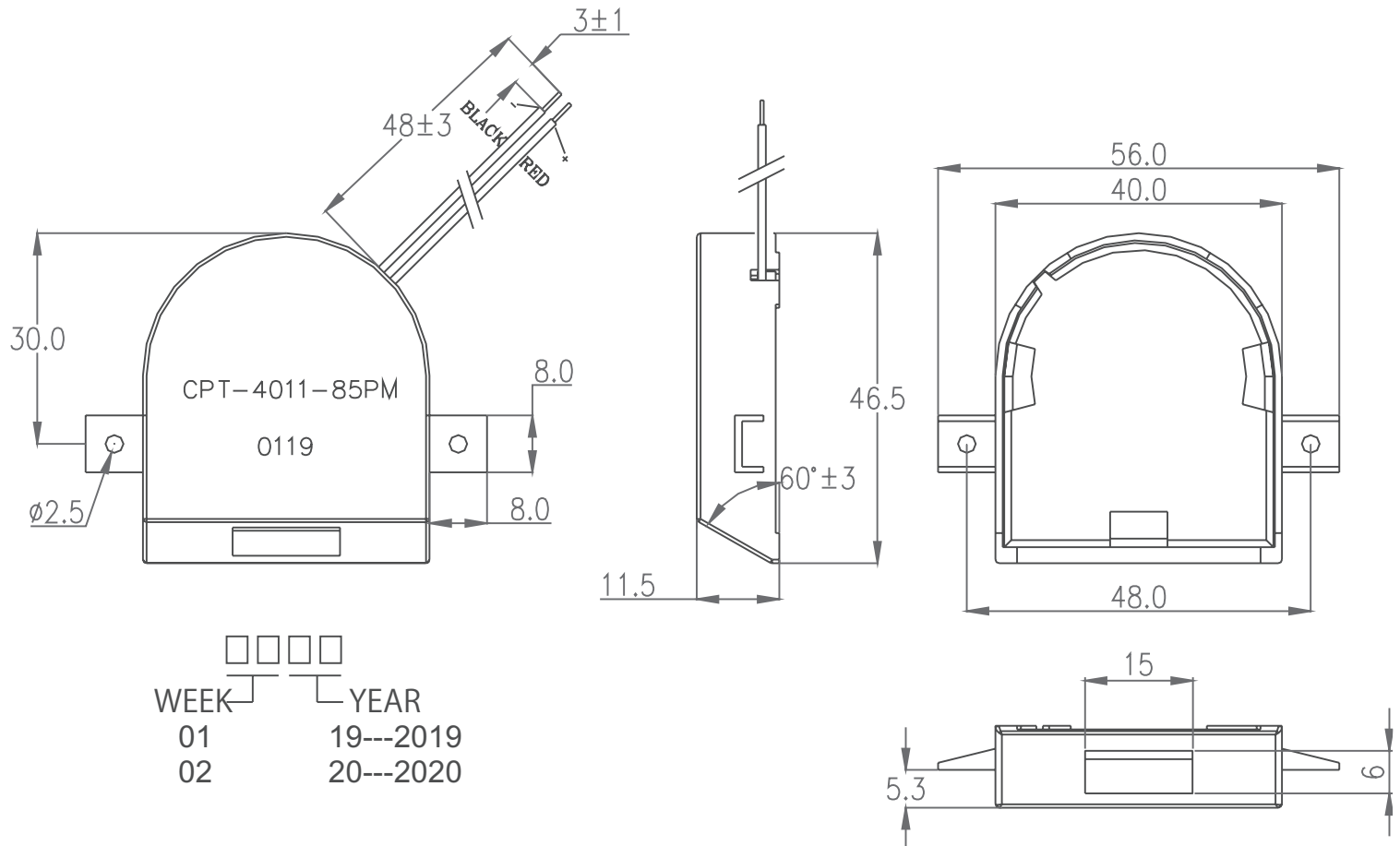

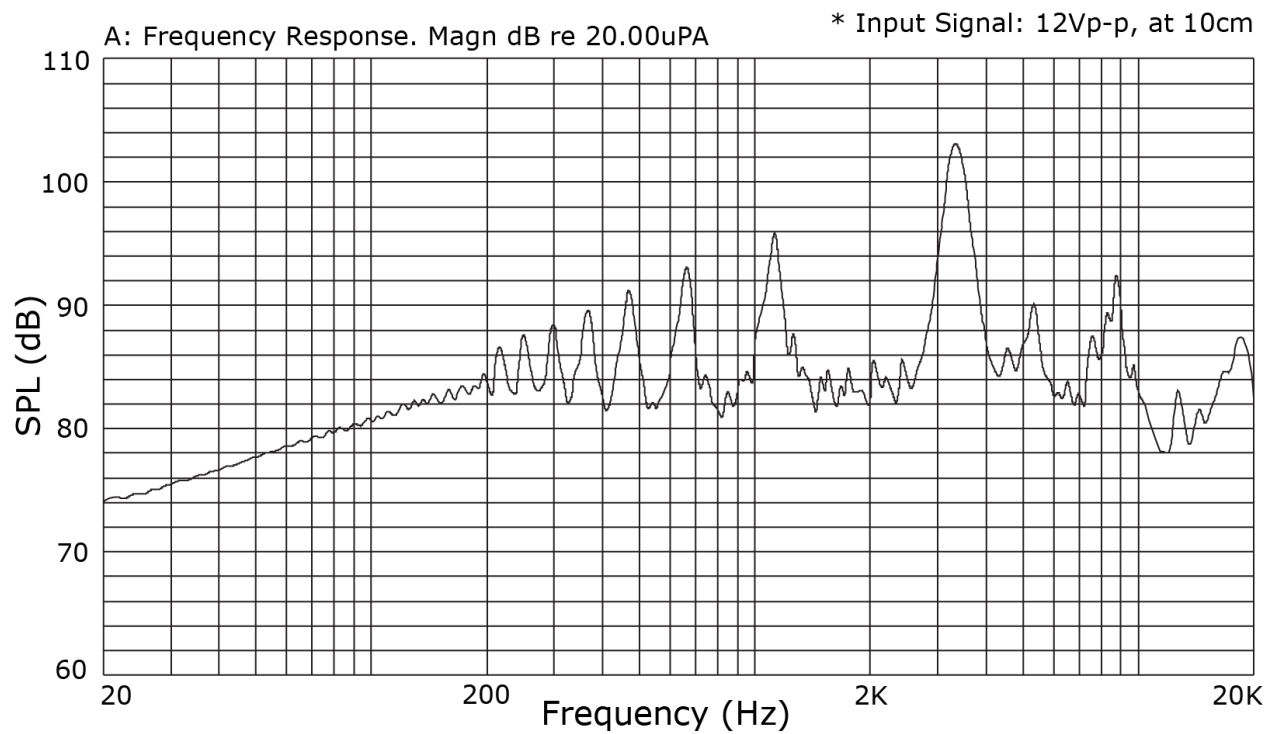

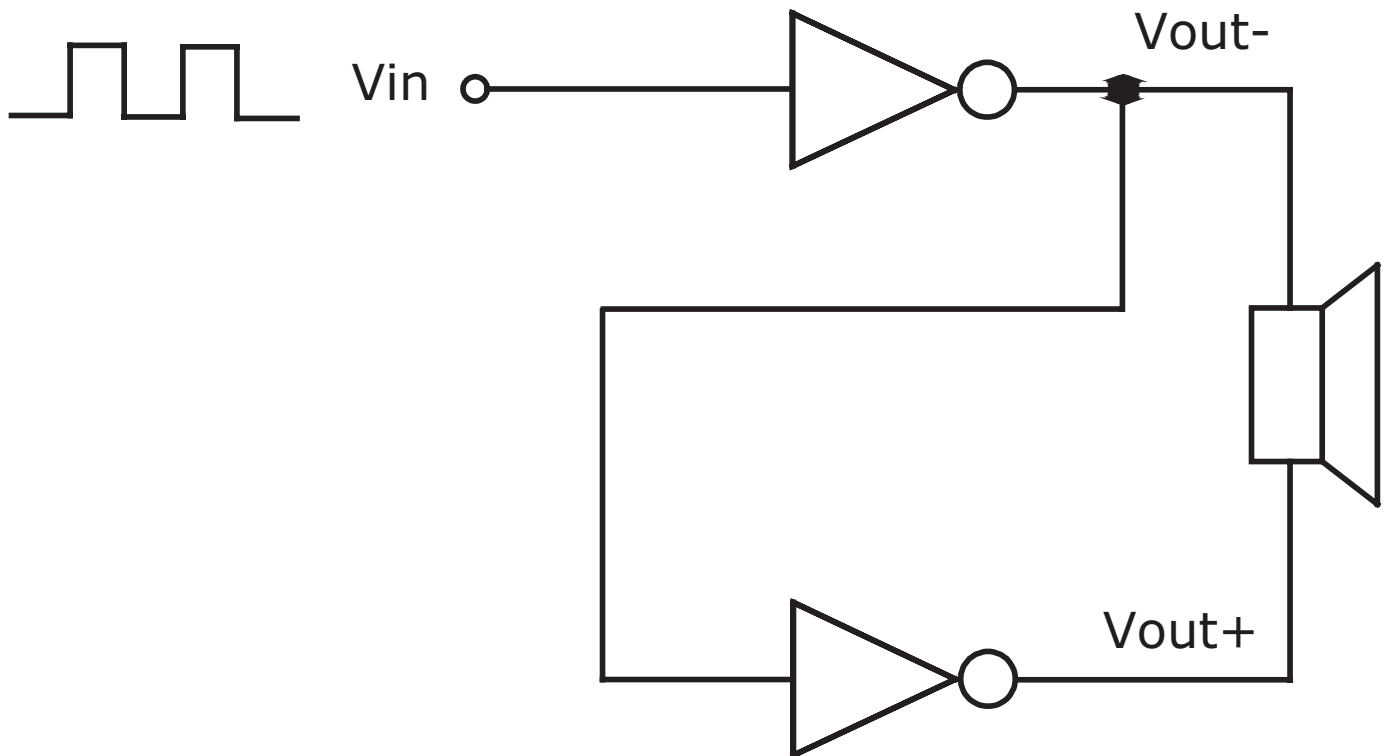

APPLICATION CIRCUIT

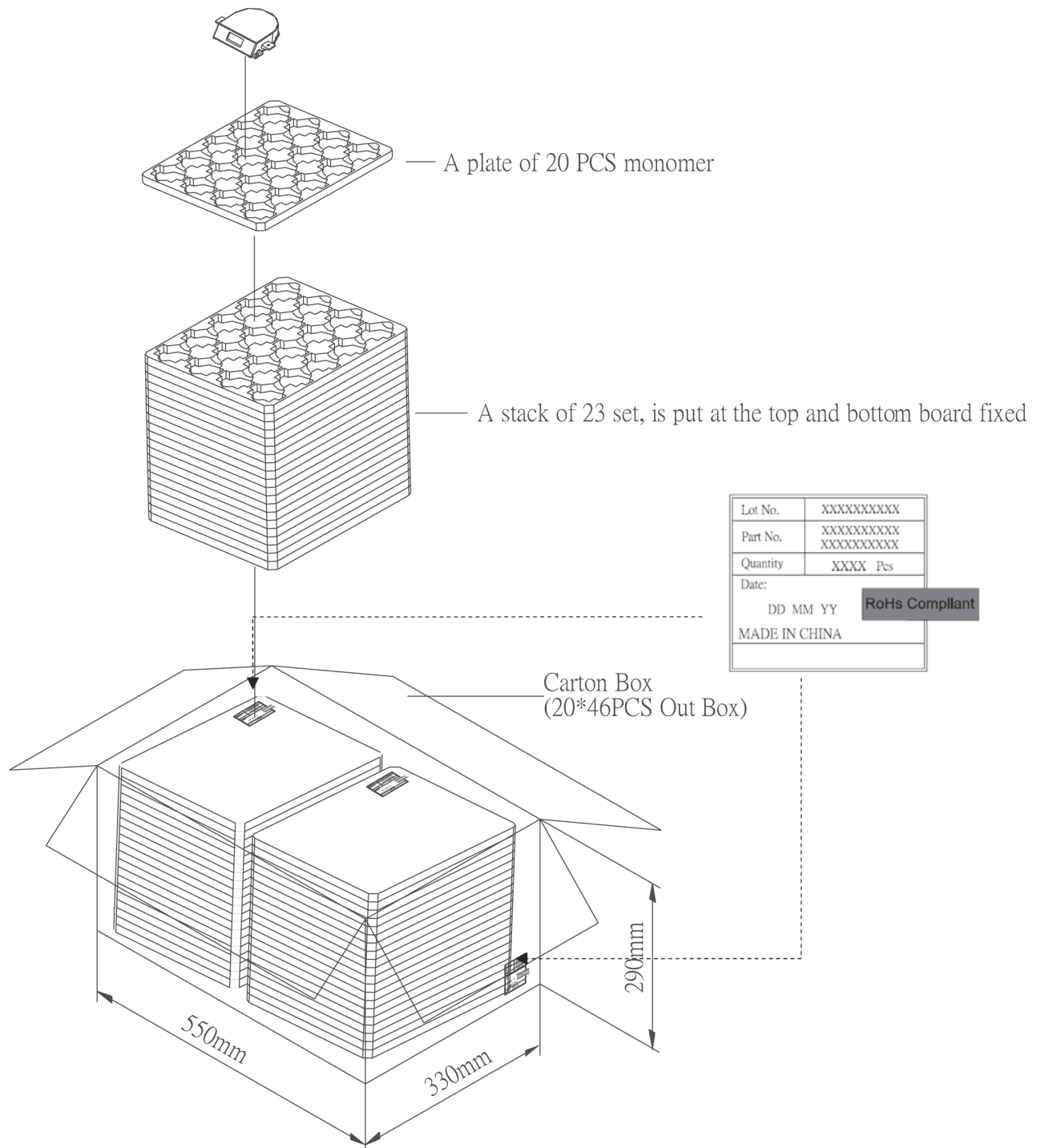
